

Dear Mr. Duvall:

Attached is a Notice of Violation and Order, Docket Number **4820-11**, for violations of permit conditions under WYPDES Permit WY0052451. Violations include failure to respond to a Letter of Violation, effluent exceedances, and failure to collect required effluent monitoring samples.

ANY APPEALS TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COUNCIL FROM THE ATTACHED ORDER MUST BE MADE IN WRITING WITHIN THE TEN (10) DAY TIME LIMIT PRESCRIBED BY W.S. 35-11-701(c). Chapter I, Section 3 of the Department of Environmental Quality Rules of Practice and Procedure (<http://soswy.state.wy.us/RULES/5675.pdf>) sets forth the requirements for the initiation of appeal proceedings.

To appeal this Order and request a hearing, you must file two (2) copies of your written petition. The first petition shall be mailed to the Chairman of the Environmental Quality Council at Room 1714, Herschler Building, 1st Floor West, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. The second petition should be sent to John V. Corra, Director, Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Herschler Building, 4th West, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. Both petitions must be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested.



NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND ORDER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

1. Snowy Range Resorts, Inc., dba Albany Lodge (Albany Lodge) operates a wastewater treatment system in Albany, Wyoming in Albany County, Wyoming which is permitted to discharge through the Wyoming Pollution Discharge Elimination System permit WY0052451.
2. Part I of the above referenced permit, under the Monitoring and Reporting Requirements requires that effluent monitoring results obtained during the previous three month(s) shall be summarized and reported on a Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR). The DMRs are to be submitted to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and postmarked no later than the 28th day of the month following the completed reporting period. To date the DEQ/Water Quality Division (WQD) has received Fourth Quarter 2010 DMRs. However, the DMRs were not complete due to failure to sample for required parameters which include; Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD), Total Suspended Solids (TSS), percent removal of TSS, percent removal of BOD, and pH at outfall 001. Only one BOD sample for the quarter was collected in December and analytical results for the sample were above the permit limit.
3. DEQ has issued a previous Letter of Violation (LOV) to Albany Lodge for failure to submit the required Annual 2010 DMR which requires a sample of Oil and Grease to be collected, analyzed and reported. To date DEQ has not received this report nor a response to the LOV, which are violations of the permit requirements.
4. This Notice is being sent to you pursuant to W.S. 35-11-701(c)(i), which requires that in any case of the failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation, the director of the Department of Environmental Quality shall cause a written notice to be issued and served upon the person alleged to be responsible.

ORDER

BEFORE THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COUNCIL – STATE OF WYOMING

WHEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Albany Lodge shall immediately submit the complete and accurate delinquent report to the WQD. This information shall be received by the WQD no later than 20 days from the date of this NOV and Order.

2. Within thirty (30) days of receipt of this Order, Albany Lodge shall submit to the WQD a written description of actions taken to insure that future required monitoring will be completed and the Discharge Monitoring Reports will be submitted on time.


This ORDER is final unless, no later than ten (10) days after the date this notice is received; it is appealed by filing two written requests for a hearing before the Environmental Quality Council. If a hearing is requested, the first hearing petition shall be mailed to the Chairman, Wyoming Environmental Quality Council, Room 1714 Herschler Building, 1st Floor West, 122 West 25th St., Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. The second petition shall be mailed to the Director, Wyoming Department of the Environmental Quality, Herschler Building, 4th Floor West, 122 West 25th St., Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. Both petitions must be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested.

NOTHING IN THIS NOTICE OF VIOLATION (NOV) AND ORDER shall be interpreted to in any way limit or contravene any other remedy available under the Environmental Quality Act, nor shall this NOV AND ORDER be interpreted as being a condition precedent to any other enforcement action.
