
NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation and Order Docket Number **4659-10** on June 14, 2010 to Trapper Trails Council, Boy Scouts of America and the National Forest Service. The NOV and Order alleged that Trapper Trails Council, Boy Scouts of America and the National Forest Service had constructed a public water supply without a permit. These are violations of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Act) and applicable Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WWQRR).

The Order required Trapper Trails Council to hire a Professional Engineer that would prepare and submit an application for the Camp New Fork public water system. After the issuance of the permit to construct, Trapper Trails Council was required to submit a construction schedule, complete construction and submit a Certification of Completion. Trapper Trails Council has complied with the conditions of the Notice of Violation and Order Docket Number **4659-10** and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied except for the receipt of the Certification of Completion. If the Certification of Completion is not received by October 31, 2012, additional enforcement actions may be initiated.

The DEQ looks forward to working with Trapper Trails Council, Boy Scouts of America and the National Forest Service in a proactive manner and is available to discuss future permitting and/or construction issues.
