
**NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE**

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation Docket Number **5033-12** on October 23, 2012 to George Bernhardt (George) of Baker-Hughes Oilfield Operations, Inc. The NOV alleged that George constructed a water and sewer system at the Baker Hughes Joint Facility in Evansville, WY without a permit to construct. This is a violation of Wyoming Statute(s) (W.S.) 35-11-301 (a)(iii) and 35-11-301(a)(v).

George Bernhardt and Baker-Hughes has submitted an application and received "as-built" permits for the construction of the water and sewer system(s). As stipulated in the settlement agreement (SA), George has paid the fine of \$15,000 to the WQD to resolve the above mentioned allegations. George Bernhardt has complied with the conditions of the SA for the Notice of Violation Docket Number **5033-12** and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.

The DEQ looks forward to working with George Bernhardt in a proactive manner and is available to discuss future permitting and/or construction issues.
