**NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE**

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued **Notice of Violation and Order Docket Number 4924-11 (NOVO)** on December 5, 2011 to Pinnacle Gas Resources (now Summit Gas Resources, Inc.) for failure to submit quarterly monitor reports for the Underground Injection Control (UIC) facilities listed in **Table 1**.

The NOVO required Summit Gas Resources, Inc. to submit all delinquent monitor reports and arrange for inspection of all facilities by DEQ personnel.

Summit Gas Resources, Inc. submitted a plugging and abandonment report on March 15, 2013 for two (2) existing wells (BCWI 9-5 and Brown 4-84-5573A). Summit Gas Resources, Inc. also requested that the UIC permits associated with these two (2) wells be cancelled. The permits associated with these wells identified in **Table 1** are hereby cancelled.

Summit Gas Resources, Inc. submitted a letter dated April 2, 2013 indicating that the remaining wells listed in **Table 1** have never been drilled and requested that the UIC permits associated with these wells be cancelled. The permits associated with the remaining wells identified in **Table 1** are hereby cancelled.

Since the wells identified in **Table 1** are either plugged and abandoned or were never drilled there are no facilities to inspect. DEQ hereby voids the inspection requirement of the NOVO.

Summit Gas Resources, Inc. has complied with all the conditions of the NOVO and the Department of Environmental Quality considers the NOVO to be satisfied.
