NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation and Order Docket Number **5123-13** on April 22, 2013 to Oilfield Disposal Services, Inc. (ODS). The NOV and Order alleged that ODS spread oily waste on the roads without a permit which threatened waters of the state. This is a violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Act) and applicable Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WWQRR).

The Order required ODS to complete the permitting process to allow applying oily waste to their roads or remove the material and dispose of it at a permitted facility. By completing the permitting process, ODS has complied with the conditions of the Notice of Violation and Order Docket Number **5123-13** and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.

The DEQ looks forward to working with ODS in a proactive manner and is available to discuss future permitting and/or construction issues.
