
**NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE**

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation Docket Number **5115-13** on January 25, 2013 to Redstone Resources (Redstone). The NOV alleged Redstone had an unpermitted discharge of CBM produced water and was in violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Act) and applicable Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WWQRR).

The Notice of Violation required Redstone to pay a total of one thousand six hundred dollars and no cents (\$1,600.00) and submit in writing actions to be taken to achieve compliance with permit requirements to the DEQ. Based on reviewed information submitted by Redstone and receipt of the penalty payment Redstone has complied with the conditions of the Settlement Agreement for Docket Number **5115-13** and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.

The DEQ looks forward to working with Redstone in a proactive manner and is available for future quarterly or semi-annual meetings to discuss compliance issues or concerns regarding WYPDES permit requirements.
