**NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE**

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation and Order Docket (NOV and Order) Number **5437-14** on July 7, 2014 to Mr. Craig Logan, Director of Operations, for the Jackson Hole Airport. The NOV and Order alleged that the Jackson Airport constructed a de-icing pad and propylene glycol collection system without a permit to construct. This is a violation of Wyoming Statute (W.S.) 35-11-301 (a)(iii).

Mr. Logan has submitted an application and received an 'As-Built' permit for the construction of the de-icing pad and propylene glycol collection system. The Jackson Hole Airport and Mr. Logan have complied with the NOV and Order Docket Number **5437-14** and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.

The DEQ looks forward to working with the Jackson Hole Airport and Mr. Logan in a proactive manner and is available to discuss future permitting and/or construction issues.
