

ANY APPEALS TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COUNCIL FROM THE ATTACHED ORDER MUST BE MADE IN WRITING WITHIN THE TEN (10) DAY TIME LIMIT PRESCRIBED BY W.S. 35-11-701(c). Chapter I, Section 3 of the Department of Environmental Quality Rules of Practice and Procedure (<http://soswy.state.wy.us/Rules/RULES/5675.pdf>) sets forth the requirements for the initiation of appeal proceedings.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND ORDER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

1. **Teton Village Water and Sewer District**, hereafter referred to as **TVWSD**, was issued coverage under Underground Injection Control (UIC) Individual Permit 13-369 (5E4) on February 4, 2014 for three (3) injection wells associated with a domestic wastewater treatment plant serving Teton Village, Teton County, Wyoming. This facility injects tertiary treated domestic wastewater into the Snake River alluvium. On average, **TVWSD** injects 492,000 gallons per day of treated waste, and has a total maximum injection volume limit of 820,000 gallons per day.

2. **TVWSD** is in violation of UIC permit 13-369, Section I (REQUIREMENTS FOR MONITORING GROUNDWATERS OF THE STATE) for exceeding the established ammonia Upper Control Limit (UCL). For the quarterly period beginning July 1, 2013 through September 30, 2013, **TVWSD** was out of compliance with the three (3) week rolling average for the ammonia UCL established in UIC permit 13-369 of 0.5 mg/L for the **TVWSD** treatment plant effluent.
3. This Notice is being sent to you pursuant to W.S. 35-11-701(c)(i), which requires that in any case of the failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation, the Director of DEQ shall cause a written notice to be issued and served on the person alleged to be responsible.

ORDER

BEFORE THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COUNCIL – STATE OF WYOMING

WHEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:


1. **Within thirty (30) days of receipt of this Order, TVWSD will:**
 - a. **Provide a plan of action to prevent plugging of sewer supply pipe lines within the TVWSD. This plan of action shall include, but is not limited to:**
 - i. **Preventative maintenance and inspection;**
 - ii. **Identification of and proper procedures for**

- iii. **mitigating plugging hazards;**
A timeline for implementing the items identified above.


This ORDER is final unless, not later than ten (10) days after the date of this notice is received it is appealed by filing a written petition for a hearing before the Environmental Quality Council. If a hearing is requested, the petition shall be mailed to: Chairman, Wyoming Environmental Quality Council, Room 1714 Herschler Building, 1st Floor West, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming, 82002. The second petition shall be mailed to: Director, Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Herschler Building, 4th Floor West, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. Both petitions must be sent via certified mail, return receipt requested.

NOTHING IN THIS ORDER shall be interpreted to in any way limit or contravene any other remedy available under the Environmental Quality Act, nor shall this ORDER be interpreted as being a condition precedent to any other enforcement action.
