NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division issued a Notice of Violation and Order (NOVO) to Matrix Oilfield Services LLC on June 28, 2013. The NOVO was issued for exceeding the maximum permitted injection rate established in Underground Injection Control (UIC) permit and well listed in **Table 1**. This was a violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act, the applicable Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations, and respective permit conditions.

Matrix Oilfield Services LLC provided an acceptable plan of action for preventing future exceedances of their permitted injection rate. No further permit exceedances have occurred. Inspection of this facility by DEQ staff (Kathy Shreve) on October 2, 2014 revealed no further issues, the facility appeared well-maintained and in good working order. The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality considers the NOVO for Docket Number 5141-13 to be satisfied.
