
NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation (NOV) Number 5000-12 on June 12, 2012 to Mr. James Bradish, Operations Superintendent for Southern Cross Environmental Services, LLC (Southern Cross). The NOV alleged that Southern Cross constructed frac rings to store produced water without a permit to construct. This is a violation of Wyoming Statute (W.S.) 35-11-301 (a) (iii).

In the settlement agreement between Southern Cross and DEQ/WQD, Southern Cross agreed to pay a fine of \$120,000 to settle NOV 5000-12. The fine has been paid in full and DEQ finds that all terms of the settlement agreement have been satisfied.

The DEQ looks forward to working with Southern Cross Environmental Services, LLC in a proactive manner and is available to discuss future permitting and/or construction issues.
