The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality/Water Quality Division (WDEQ/WQD) is conducting public outreach related to upcoming revisions to Water Quality Rules and Regulations, Chapter 1, Wyoming Surface Water Quality Standards. The public is invited to attend and comment at two public hearings on September 24, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. in the hearing room at the Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission Building, 2211 King Boulevard in Casper and on September 28, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. in the ANB Bank Leadership Center Room 108 at the Clay Pathfinder Building of Laramie County Community College, 1400 East College Drive in Cheyenne. Written and electronic comments received by 5:00 p.m. (MDT) on October 12th, 2018 will be considered.
