COMMENTS: An initial review of your plans and specifications has been made. Before the review can be completed and a "Permit to Construct" issued, the following points need to be resolved or addressed:

1. Two additional copies of Plan Sheet 3 of 4 are required. Only one was enclosed with the 4 sets of plans.
2. More information is needed as to the dewatering structure of Pond F, such as:
 - a) pipe material,
 - b) valve type,
 - c) seepage blocks in dike,
 - d) recommend railings along the walkway.
3. Information is needed as to rip-rap material and sizes for the Pond F spillway.
4. For Ponds B, C, D, and F:

Section 2 states no discharge permit is required but Section 2.4 says discharge will take place when the water meets the conditions of FMC's discharge permit. Reference "Permit to Construct" Plans and Specification #81-540 "...a discharge permit will not be required specifically for this structure. Any discharge of water from the reservoir will be covered by FMC's NPDES Permit." Include the NPDES Permit number on the application.

In reference to your recent letter on treatment alternatives for Point of Rocks, I have inquired as to the possibility of your receiving EPA construction grant funding and have found that your chances are slim at best. For this reason, I would recommend that you pursue the remaining alternatives and choose the one most cost effective.

I would offer the suggestion that you consider upgrading the present lagoon system with aeration and modest expansion and apply for a discharge permit. While this will require maintenance, it will be less than that required for a mechanical plant. Also, it would minimize your initial dirt work and help keep that cost down.

As we have discussed, your construction permit for the R. V. Park must be held until you have made a commitment on what type of sewage treatment is to be provided.

1. Information is needed as to the operation of the total containment-evaporative wastewater treatment ponds. Include information such as: piping flexibility, flow equalization, liner repair-flow to pond 2 without flow to pond 1, etc.
2. Address the provision for disinfection of the water supply if routine monthly testing indicates that disinfection is needed.
3. Indicate water line locations on sewer line profiles. Refer to Ten State Standards for Water Works Section 8.6 for required separation distances.
4. Address the saturated soil conditions and bearing capacities of the soil to encountered at the proposed 400,000 gallon reservoir location.
5. A more detailed description of the proposed reservoir is needed. Include structural-loading analyses.

6. Information is needed as to how the water system will be drained following the summer season. Some provision must be made for disinfecting the water each spring prior to seasonal use. Address this procedure.

(a) the riser pipe shall be protected by a concrete pad a minimum of 4 inches thick and 12 inches diameter, (b) the riser shall terminate 4 inches above natural ground, standing water or surface water run off whichever elevation is higher, and (c) the water riser should be located a minimum of 5 feet horizontally from the sewer riser.
8. Information is needed justifying the proposed spring will provide the required water flow to the park and subdivision. A more detailed description of the spring collection system is needed on the plans.

The criteria in the second sentence is a design problem and the engineer needs to design and specify this information, not the contractor.

- 2. Backflushing.

The use of a "sewer" cleaner in a potable water supply is a poor operation and maintenance recommendation and goes against basic sanitary design unless the cleaner is used entirely on potable lines. Also, the cleaner will not do any good except to flush the lines in which case there should only be minimal deposition anyway. The cleaner will not do any good for cleansing the well screen and certainly will not clear the gravel pack of any sediment deposition.

Also, I do not understand how the cleanouts will be used for flushing the backwash discharge in the future. There should only be minimal solids in the collection line. The cleanouts may be used for pressurizing the collection lines for backwashing but then these lines need to high pressure pipe, thrust blocks and have pressure caps if this is the future intention. Also, at a minimum, valves need to be placed on all lines entering the 8 foot collection manhole for maintenance purposes.

- 3. Gravel pack and well screen.

I question the purpose of the gravel pack and the well screen. If the purpose is to reduce turbidity, the large rock sizes will not serve this purpose and turbidity will pass straight through. If the purpose is to keep debris out of the intake, then I suggest a larger well slot size as the slots will quickly plug with sand and no method is provided for cleaning the outside of the screen.

1. The seasonal high groundwater table was not established. The 8 foot depth to groundwater during July is not adequate. Since a 10 foot hole was dug, evidence (mottling) of seasonal high groundwater could easily be established.
2. Based on the information provided, a groundwater mounding model was performed which showed that a mound 5.2 feet high would develop above the existing groundwater table. This would not only flood the bed but would also not provide adequate treatment. A minimum of 3 feet of unsaturated soil must be obtained between the bottom of the leachfield stone and the mound which develops beneath the bed.
3. Please submit a layout of which houses will be connected to this system.
4. Building paper, straw, or filter fabric is required between the stone and soil cover. The bottom of the bed must be level.







Furthermore, more recent research and experience has shown that the biological mat which develops between the stone and soil will control the application rate after a few months operation. The acceptance rate of the biological mat on soils having a percolation rate of 2 minute per inch will be about 0.8 gallons per square foot per day. This is for all infiltrative surfaces below the distribution pipe. Therefore, the size of this proposed system must be increased.
2. A site plan showing all buildings, driveways, parking lots and any other facilities in the vicinity of this proposed system must be provided. Therefore, we will withhold authorization of this project until final plans are available. However, the general concept of the plans is acceptable, and the plans should be authorized when final plans are submitted.
