The above referenced facility is authorized under UIC General Permit 5E5-5C6, a copy of which is enclosed with this letter. This general permit does not require monitoring of the effluent or the groundwater, and its use is restricted to large capacity septic systems which reach that capacity infrequently.

If you have any questions concerning underground injection, or treatment of effluents, please do not hesitate to call me at (307) 777-7095, by FAX to (307) 777-5973 or by internet to [blucht@state.wy.us](mailto:blucht@state.wy.us).

The Underground Injection Control Program was established in part to insure that large capacity septic systems are not only properly operated, but also monitored to detect any pollution caused by their operation. This is an important aspect since without monitoring, it would be impossible to determine if a large capacity septic system was causing a groundwater problem until the problem became severe enough to affect a water well nearby. Some large capacity systems have been shown to cause pollution of the groundwater with Ammonia or Nitrates or both, and some have even been shown to be the source of other pollutants. Your cooperation with our program is important to our success in insuring that these systems do not cause problems.

If the applicant fails to provide the requested information within six months the incomplete application shall be returned.

This application is jointly reviewed by Sheridan County and Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (WDEQ) as it is a commercial facility.

**COMMENTS:**

1.) The percolation test submitted is incomplete. Measurements must be taken in each hole until you see 3 drops w/in 1/8" or less. Making classification of the soil by registered geologist is acceptable, but information submitted does not show a clear picture of how the soil percolates. The information submitted does not seem to justify the 20 min/inch used in calculations to size the absorption field as one test pit was tested at 30 min/inch. The backhoe pits used for the tests were all located on the very upstream end (east) of the proposed field. No tests were performed on the downstream (west) end of the field. Please provide percolation test data for the western end of the proposed field.

2.) The location of the proposed absorption field is very close to a vertical wall. The exact location of the wall in relation to the field is not depicted on the map. Please provide a more detailed map showing location of the slope (wall). This map should show height of wall and distance from nearest leach line to slope. This distance must be greater than 15', horizontal per Chapter 11, Section 36 (e) (iii) (page 94).

3.) It is stated in the engineering design report that septic tanks have been installed. Construction without a permit violates the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act, specifically Wyoming Statute (W.S.) 35-11-30. Pursuant to W.S. 35-11-901 any person who violates any provision of the Environmental Quality Act is subject to a penalty for each violation. Please provide reasoning behind the installation of the tanks w/out a permit.

4.) The application does not show an area for a replacement absorption field. Please submit map showing this location.

5.) This system is considered a "Dosing System" and shall meet all requirements of Chapter 11, Section 40. Please provide all information requested in this section of the WWQRR, this section has been attached for your use.

The permittee shall allow authorized representatives from the DEQ, Water Quality Division (WQD), to enter and inspect any property, premise or place on or at which the facility is located or is being constructed or installed for the purpose of investigating actual or potential sources of water pollution, and for determining compliance, or non-compliance with any rules, regulations, standards, permits or orders.

The permittee shall notify representatives from the DEQ, Water Quality Division the day construction commences and give an estimate of completion of the project. 



  - c. Certification the facility was constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of the permit; or
  - d. Certification the facility was completed with changes or modifications. Submittal of as-constructed plans and specifications for the system as it was constructed, certified by an engineer if appropriate.
- 3 of 4 The review and approval of this permit is based upon the items identified in the attached "Statement of Basis".
- 4 of 4 If sewage spills or complaints of clogged sewer lines result because of permittee's inability to adequately perform maintenance, and/or the deviations from required manhole placement that were granted for this project, the permittee shall install additional manholes to meet the requirements of Chapter 11, Section 9 (d)(i) of the Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations or as directed by the Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Water Quality.

Because of the configuration of the proposed RV Campground and the availability of risers along each lateral line, manholes are not being required at some minor intersections or the ends of several lateral sewage collection lines. Cleanouts of the same diameter as the mains will be installed in lieu of manholes at the ends of the lateral lines, which are approximately 250 feet in length. If manholes are later found to be needed at any of these locations, their installation will be required.
