Our records indicate that a written review was done of the above referenced project on February 5, 2004. A copy of this review was sent to you, requesting additional information. The requested information necessary to process this application has not yet been received by the Department of Environmental Quality.

According to Chapter 3, Section 9 (a)(ii)(B) of the Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations, if an application is denied because of incompleteness necessitating a request for additional information, the applicant shall have a maximum of six months to comply with the request. If the applicant fails to provide the requested information within that period, the entire incomplete application shall be returned.

Per your verbal request last fall regarding this, we are returning the application for this project to you. You may resubmit the application, with a response to all of the deficiencies noted in the written review dated February 5, 2004, if you wish. It should be noted, however, that construction of this project without a permit is a violation of W.S. 35-11-301 and may lead to the imposition of penalties.



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 2. Section 9, (f) (ii)-Horizontal and vertical separation from water mains. Minimum vertical separation shall be 1.5 feet at crossing.
 - b. Briefly state the basis for the deviation.
 1. This sewer replacement is for an existing pipe system located immediately upstream from the Wastewater Treatment Plant. The new 30" sewer must fit between a beginning and ending existing grade and the available slope will not meet Section 9, (i) (C).
 2. The new 30" sanitary sewer identifies a waterline crossing at station 0+95 on Section D. This location is shown below the new sewer main and is approximate. The location of this waterline shall be verified during the construction and the minimum vertical distance of 1.5' shall be maintained or a low strength flowable fill used to encase the waterline as given in WDEQ Policy 13.9.11.

4. A review to determine groundwater impacts in accordance with Section 17, Chapter 3 was required.

 - a. The facility is designed and will be operated so that it will not to violate groundwater standards.
The existing run-off pond originally built in 1983-1984 is being modified and relined. The new liner will be constructed of 13" to 15" of soil bentonite mixture with an in place permeability of 3.3×10^{-8} cm/sec or less. This exceeds the Chapter 11 requirement of 3 ft of material with a permeability of 1×10^{-7} or less. 18" of concrete rubble rip-rap will be placed on the slopes subject to wind and wave erosion.
 - b. If any groundwater quality standards are to be exceeded, briefly describe how any users of the affected aquifer will be protected. The description should include the water quality standard affected, the anticipated maximum concentration, the property boundaries, places of groundwater withdrawal and any other relevant information.
The existing facility has resulted in a violation of groundwater standards for ammonia. Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality Notice of Violation, Docket No. 3578-04 has been issued to address the groundwater ammonia concentration violation.
 - c. Briefly describe monitoring plan. The groundwater monitoring plan includes the monitoring wells or other sampling points, the parameters to be analyzed, the sampling frequency and reporting methods.
The existing monitoring well network and monthly monitoring requirements remain in effect. Additional monitoring and reporting may be required by the Water Quality Division Groundwater Section as part of the settlement or litigation of NOV Docket No. 3578-04.





1.0 SITE SUMMARY:

1.1 Site Description. The site is located in downtown Pinedale WY, and is a "strip mall" that houses many various types of businesses. The location of the building is 219 East Pine Street, SWSW 1/4 of Section 34, T34N, R109W. The building used two USTs for heating oil, one on the eastern (1000 gallon) and one on the western (500 gallon) side of the building.

1.2 Site History. In 1990 Chen Northern performed a Phase I site investigation for Prudential Properties in anticipation of the sale of the property. Several soil borings were constructed and four soil samples and one groundwater sample were collected for laboratory analyses. Analyses from the soil samples indicate that hydrocarbon contamination is present at both sites, most likely from overfills and spillage during UST filling operations. No additional field work was performed until 2003 when soil samples were collected during the excavation of the eastern tank and the investigation of the western tank. The soil around the eastern site was relatively clean, the soil around the western tank had TPH-DRO and TPH-GRO readings above WQD standards.

1.3 Summary of Soil and Groundwater Contamination. TPH-DRO and TPH-GRO soil contamination has been identified adjacent to the western UST at levels of 6,000 and 240 mg/kg respectively. A single groundwater sample obtained from a borehole in 1990 had a TPH reading of 16 mg/l. Both readings are above WQD standards.

1.4 Hydrogeology. The surface geology of the site is a silty, gravelly sand to a depth of at least 15.5 feet. Groundwater was encountered at a depth of 4 to 7 feet. Based on information from several wells located on adjacent properties, the groundwater flow direction is mainly southerly. No other information is available.

2.0 SUMMARY OF WORK COMPLETED TO DATE:

2.1 1990 Chen Northern Investigation. Chen Northern performed a Phase I site assessment for Prudential Properties. A review of property records, maps and other documents was performed. Five (5) soil borings were installed at the site. Soil samples were screened in the field with a HNu hydrocarbon detector and four samples were sent to a laboratory for analysis. One groundwater sample was obtained from boring BH-1, which was located just south of the western UST. TPH was analyzed in the four soil samples and one soil sample was analyzed for benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene and xylene (BTEX). Sample B-2, near the western UST, had a TPH detection of 612 mg/kg. Sample B-4 was analyzed for the BTEX and TPH compounds. The BTEX results were 824/283/<20/<20 µg/l respectively. The TPH was <10 mg/kg. The groundwater sample was analyzed for BTEX and TPH. The only detection was for TPH at 16 mg/l.

The report concluded that the tanks were not leaking, because the contaminant concentrations were not high enough, and the soil contamination appeared to be near the surface. The contamination was thought to be from overfills and spillage.

2.2 October 2003 UST Report In response to a WQD letter (September 9, 2002 letter), a field investigation and tank removal was performed in October 2003. GeoScience and Engineering performed soil testing during the excavation and removal of the eastern UST, and collected samples from a trench dug adjacent to the western UST. The western UST was not removed because a concrete sidewalk has been poured over it. The eastern tank had 880 gallons of fuel removed prior to the tank being excavated and removed. No fuel odors were noted during this tank pull, the soil appeared to be clean, and the tank appeared in good condition with "competent steel beneath a layer of rust". A single soil sample was collected and analyzed for BTEX, naphthalene(N) and TPH-DRO and TPH-GRO. This soil sample was non-detect for all analytes.

The west UST had approximately 71 gallons of fuel in it, which was removed during this work. A trench was dug adjacent to the west end of this tank and the report states that "fuel odors were prominent in the area of this excavation." A soil sample was collected and analyzed for the same parameters as listed above. Xylene and naphthalene were detected at 4.6 and 4.5 mg/kg respectively. The TPH-GRO and TPH-DRO readings were 240 and 6,000 mg/kg respectively. These TPH levels are above WQD standards. The western tank was left in place.

2.3 January 2004 Remedial Action Plan. This RAP provides a plan for excavating the hydrocarbon contaminated soil, removing the western UST, and testing the groundwater adjacent to the UST location to determine if groundwater has been impacted. Any impacted soil, as measured by visual, odor, and photoionization detector, will be excavated and placed on plastic sheeting for sampling. Confirmation soil samples from the sides and the bottom of the excavation will also be collected. The soil will be analyzed for TPH-DRO using EPA method 8015. The excavation will be backfilled once samples are collected. Once the laboratory results from the soil samples are returned, the excavated soil will be properly disposed of, or treated if necessary.

The groundwater at the site has not been evaluated since the initial 1990 investigation when a "grab" sample was obtained from one of the soil borings. During this field work, a single groundwater monitoring well will be installed just down gradient (south) of the tank basin. There are several groundwater monitoring wells on the adjacent property, so the direction of flow and depth to groundwater is well known. The groundwater will be analyzed for TPH-DRO using EPA method 8015. It is not anticipated that there will be groundwater contamination. A report on the investigation and disposal of the soil will be submitted to this office shortly after the receipt of the lab analyses.

3.0 REQUESTS/REQUIREMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

3.1 We concur with the plan for excavating and removing the western UST. We ask that the soil confirmation sampling for the excavation be performed as described in the attached VRP Fact Sheet #10. Also, the soil pile from the excavation needs to be sampled according to procedures provided in SHWD Guideline #2 for Petroleum Contaminated Soil that you are familiar with.

For the groundwater sampling, one well is sufficient for the stated purpose. Please be aware that if groundwater contamination is discovered, additional wells may need to be installed to determine the nature and extent of the groundwater contamination. Also, in addition to TPH-DRO, please analyze the groundwater for TPH-GRO using EPA method 8015, and for BTEX and naphthalene using EPA method 8260 or similar. This will allow us to evaluate the nature of the hydrocarbon contamination and to determine if an additional investigation and/or remediation needs to be performed.

3.2 You chose to remain with the Chapter 3 permitting process. Thank you for your decision.

The above application for coverage under General Permit to Construct, Install, Modify, or Operate a Small Wastewater Facility in accordance with Chapter 3, Section 9 of the Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations has been reviewed and is hereby approved. You are authorized to construct, install, or modify the small wastewater system in accordance with Chapter 11, Part D of the Water Quality Division Rules and Regulations, the general permit, the conditions listed below, and the materials submitted in your application package. Your attention is directed to the mandatory reporting requirements outlined in Part V, Section O of the general permit. Additionally, the following project specific conditions also apply:

1. Septic Tank Clean-Out Riser Requirement - Either a 6 inch diameter clean-out riser or the manway from **each compartment of the tank** must be extended to the ground surface.
2. Polyethylene Septic Tank Installation Requirements - To ensure structural integrity, the **manufacturer's instructions** regarding bedding the tank and filling the tank with water during burial **must be followed during installation**. Additionally, immediately after clean-outs, the tank must be refilled with water according to the manufacturer's instructions to maintain structural integrity.
3. Leachfield Header Pipe Layout - It is critical that the effluent from the septic tank be divided relatively equally between the leachfield trenches. The arrangement shown on your site plan (3 trenches - 2 at 50 feet long and 1 at 12.5 feet long) will not accomplish this. Therefore, you **SHALL INSTALL ONLY TWO TRENCHES, each 57 feet long**, with a header pipe arrangement as shown on the "Two Trench Chambered Leachfield" detail sheet included with this approval notification. This will provide for the equal effluent distribution needed for the system to work it's best.


