This permit hereby authorizes the applicant:

Town of Manderson

Manderson, Wyoming 82432

to construct, install or modify a community sewer system consisting of individual filtered septic tanks and a new community collection system with treatment through a recirculating Advantex filter system and UV disinfection of the filtered effluent prior to discharge to the Nowood River, and associated appurtenances according to the procedures and conditions of the application number 04-504RR. The facility is located in SW1/4 Section 30 and NW1/4 Section 31, Township 50 North, Range 92 West in the county of Big Horn, in the State of Wyoming. All construction, installation, or modification allowed by this permit shall be completed by December 31, 2005.

The issuance of this permit confirms that the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has evaluated the application submitted by the permittee and determined that it meets minimum applicable construction and design standards. The compliance with construction standards and the operation and maintenance of the facility to meet the engineer's design are the responsibility of the permittee, owner, and operator.

Granting this permit does not imply that DEQ guarantees or ensures that the permitted facility, when constructed, will meet applicable discharge permit conditions or other effluent or operational requirements. Compliance with discharge standards remains the responsibility of the permittee.

Nothing in this permit constitutes an endorsement by DEQ of the construction or the design of the facility described herein. This permit verifies only that the submitted application meets the design and construction standards imposed by Wyoming statutes, rules and regulations. The DEQ assumes no liability for, and does not in any way guarantee or warrant the performance or operation of the permitted facility. The permittee, owner and operator are solely responsible for any liability arising from the construction or operation of the permitted facility. By issuing this permit, the State of Wyoming does not waive its sovereign immunity.

The permittee shall allow authorized representatives from DEQ to enter and inspect any property, premise or place on or at which the facility is located or is being constructed or installed for the purpose of investigating actual or potential sources of water pollution, and for determining compliance or non-compliance with any rules, regulations, standards, permits or orders.

Nothing in this permit shall be construed to preclude the institution of any legal action or other proceeding to enforce any applicable provision of law or rules and regulations. It is the duty of the

permittee, owner and operator to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws or regulations in the exercise of its activities authorized by this permit.

The issuance of this permit does not convey any property rights in either real or personal property or any invasion of personal rights, nor any infringement of federal, state or local laws or regulations.

The permittee shall construct and operate the permitted facility in accordance with the statements, representations, procedures, terms and conditions of the permit application, supporting documents and permit. This permit does not relieve the permittee from any duty to obtain any other permit or authorization that may be required by any provision of federal, state or local laws.

In carrying out its activities authorized by this permit, the permittee, owner and operator shall comply with all of the following permit conditions:

1 of 9 The applicant will provide immediate oral or written notice to the DEQ/WQD Northwest District Office in accordance with the provisions of Section 11, Chapter 3, Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations of any changes or modifications which are not consistent with the terms and conditions of this permit.

2 of 9 Within sixty days of completion of construction of the authorized facility, the applicant will submit to the DEQ/WQD Northwest District Office on the form provided (CERTIFICATION OF COMPLETION), the following information:

- a. Date that construction of the facility was completed; and
- b. Date that the facility was placed in operation; and
- c. Certification the facility was constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of the permit; or
- d. Certification the facility was completed with changes or modifications. Submittal of as-constructed plans and specifications for the system as it was constructed, certified by an engineer if appropriate. All modifications or deviations from the authorized plans must be highlighted.

3 of 9 The review and approval of this permit is based upon the items identified in the attached "Statement of Basis".

4 of 9 The applicant must submit stamped drawings, specifications, and calculations for the 25,000 gallon recirculation tank before construction starts.

5 of 9 The applicant must be in compliance with the regulations regarding operator certification (WWQRR Chapter 5) before commencing operation of this facility.


6 of 9 The applicant must contract with the manufacturer of the AdvanTex Treatment System (or its equal, if used) for manufacturer's standard operation and maintenance services for at least the initial two year warranty period, and applicant's certified chief and backup operators must be trained by the manufacturer during that time specifically for the operation and maintenance of the AdvanTex system.

7 of 9 The applicant must submit a complete Operation and Maintenance manual before operations commence. The O&M Manual shall meet the requirements of WWQRR Chapter 11 Section 24.

8 of 9 The applicant must require all entities currently connected to the illegal discharge to the Nowood River to have a properly filtered septic tank and be connected to this new system within sixty days after system startup.

9 of 9 The applicant must check each septic tank connected to the system at least once every two years and pump each tank when necessary. The applicant must keep records documenting septic tank inspections and pumping.

STATEMENT OF BASIS

1. Permit Number: 04-504RR
2. Application reviewed for compliance with the following applicable regulations :
 - a. Chapter 11.
3. Does the permit comply with all applicable regulations identified above?
 - a. The permit approval is based upon a deviation from applicable regulations in accordance with Section 5. of Chapter 11.
4. Facilities not specifically covered by regulations
 - a. Identify specific sections of the regulations for which a deviation is approved and briefly summarize the regulation.
 - (1) The regulations do not specifically cover ultraviolet disinfection or enhanced onsite treatment such as the Advantex system.
 - (2) Chapter 11 Section 9 (c) (i) gives minimum sewer main size of 8" and minimum slopes to achieve minimum velocity of 2 fps. Chapter 11 Section 9 (d) calls for maximum manhole spacing of 400 feet.
 - b. Briefly state the basis for the deviation.
 - (1) Chapter 11 Section 5 provides criteria for evaluating technologies not specifically covered by the regulations. The Advantex system is a recirculating textile filter system similar in concept to a recirculating sand filter. The Advantex system has been successfully used in Wyoming as part of several single dwelling enhanced onsite treatment systems. The facility to which this permit applies will be a larger system serving multiple dwellings, a school, and a cafe, but it is designed with similar loading rates (flowrate per surface area). The applicant's engineer provided information on facilities in Wyoming that are using similar ultraviolet (UV) disinfection equipment by the same manufacturer. Those existing facilities use UV disinfection following recirculating sand filters. Room is available at the proposed facility for adding additional Advantex filter beds and UV units if the design loading rates are found to be too high.
 - (2) The intent of these regulations is to minimize deposition of large solids typically found in a gravity sewer and to allow cleaning of these solids. Since the flow in this sewer will be filtered septic tank effluent, solids deposition and cleaning requirements should be minimal. The sizes, slopes, manholes, and cleanouts proposed should be adequate.
5. Application requires review to determine groundwater impacts in accordance with Section 17, Chapter 3.

6. Documentation of Statement of Basis.

The archives file for this permit will include adequate documentation of all sections of this Statement of Basis.

CERTIFICATION

The issuance of this permit is based upon a review of the application package submitted in accordance with the requirements of Section 6, Chapter III, Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations. This review was performed by Kevin Frank, PE, SRF Program Senior Analyst, and Mark Baron, PE, NW District Senior Analyst, and completed on January 28, 2005. Permit issuance is recommended based upon statements, representations, and procedures presented in the permit application and supporting documents, permit conditions, and the items identified in this "Statement of Basis."

Dear Mr. Burkland:

An application was submitted for an Underground Injection Control (UIC) Class 5E permit due to the expansion of your facility. It was identified that the daily peak wastewater flow of your expanded facility would be greater than 2,000 gallons per day which has historically required the issuance of an UIC Class V permit. However, revised policy 9.2.2 changed the 2,000 gallons per day (gpd) requirement from a "peak flow" to an "average flow."

An analysis by your consultant, Jamie Boos with Summit Consulting Group, demonstrated that the average wastewater flow from your expanded facility should be less than 2,000 gpd, thus, releasing your facility from the UIC Class V permit requirements. Your consultant also demonstrated that the existing septic tank and leachfield system was sized to serve the expanded facility. Thus, a Class 5E permit is not required for the proposed expansion of your facility.

It should be noted that any future expansion, beyond what is currently proposed, would most likely classify your facility as Class 5E facility and may exceed the design capacity of your septic tank and leachfield system. We understand that both you and your consultant have a complete set of this application; thus, we will recycle the copies rather than mailing them back to you.
