

In carrying out the activities authorized by this permit, the permittee, owner and/or operator shall comply with all of the following permit conditions:

- 1 of 4 This permit is for an enhanced (1500 gallon septic tank with a 0.5 MicroFast Treatment Unit) small wastewater treatment system. The permittee is required to obtain a maintenance contract and submit annual documentation that maintenance is being provided in accordance with the manufacturer requirements and recommendations and the permit conditions. Authority for this requirement is found in Sections 11 (a) and (c), Chapter 3 of the Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations. Annual maintenance documentation must be submitted before December 31 of each year, starting December 31, 2008 to: Southwest District Engineer, Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, 510 Meadowview Drive, Lander, WY 82520. Failure to submit annual maintenance documentation is a violation of the compliance requirements for this permit issued under Wyoming Statute 35-11-301.

2 of 4 The permittee shall ensure that the system is maintained and regularly serviced, as recommended by the manufacturer, for the life of the system. An inspection of the system, as recommended by the manufacturer in the owner's manual, shall be performed every six months by a qualified or certified individual to ensure the system is operating correctly, and to determine when maintenance is required.

3 of 4 In the event that authority for permitting enhanced small wastewater treatment systems is delegated to Sublette County by the Department of Environmental Quality, the permittee shall be subject to all county requirements and resolutions that may be in effect, or subsequently enacted, affecting the inspection, operation, maintenance, monitoring, or replacement of this system.

4 of 4 This small enhanced wastewater treatment system must continually achieving the following minimum treatment standards as required by Chapter 23, Section 7(d)(viii)(C) of the Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations at a depth of at least 6 feet above the seasonally high groundwater:

- Fecal Coliform: < 800 colonies/100mL (maximum 30 day geometric mean)
- Total Kjeldahl Nitrogen: < 25mg/L (maximum 30 day average)







The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality has completed the review of the proposed Whispering Hills Subdivision, Laramie County, WDEQ Application #07-613 subdivision of portions of Section 6 T13N R68W 6th P.M., Section 1 T13N R69W 6th P.M, and Sections 30 and 31 of T14N R68W 6th P.M in Laramie County, Wyoming. The Whispering Hills Subdivision will create 146 residential lots out of approximately 1552 acres. The information was submitted by Terracon, 1505 Old Happy Jack Road, Cheyenne, Wyoming, signed by Susan Cordery-Cotter, P.E., a Wyoming Licensed Engineer and signed by Andrew Smits, P.G. a Wyoming Professional Geologist. This letter represents the recommendations of the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality as required W.S. 18-5-306 (c).

Findings as to the safety and adequacy of the proposed sewage system:

The proposed sewage system is the use of individual on-site septic tanks and leach fields permitted by and constructed to Laramie County standards and in compliance with Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality Water Quality Rules and Regulations. The information submitted addresses the safety and adequacy of the proposed sewage system.

Findings as to the safety and adequacy of the proposed water system:

The proposed water system is individual water supply wells completed on each lot. Each well must be permitted by and constructed to the State Engineer's Office standards. The information submitted addresses the safety and adequacy of the proposed water system, provided compliance with the statements indicated in the "Notes required to be added to the final plat, and other pertinent documents"

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Notes required to be added to the final plat, and other pertinent documents:

1. Individual on-site water-supply wells shall extend into the Lance Formation to a minimum depth of at least 80 ft below the top of the Lance Formation. All wells shall be drilled a minimum of 630 ft deep unless the top of the Lance is identified as being less than 520 ft deep by a Wyoming Professional Geologist.
2. Individual on-site water-supply wells shall be installed in the Lance Formation. Final well depth and construction details shall be determined with the depth and construction details based on the yield. *The minimum construction details are as follows:*
 - a. The wells shall be screened for a minimum length of 60 feet within confined, water-bearing zones of the Lance Formation.
 - b. The top of the well screen shall be a minimum of 100 feet below the static water level in the Lance Formation
 - c. The well shall have a solid inner casing from the ground surface to the top of screen.
 - d. The top of the sand filter/gravel pack shall be no less than ten feet below the top of the Lance Formation.
 - e. A bentonite seal shall be placed on top of the sand filter, extending for at least five feet above the top of the filter, but no higher than the top of the Lance Formation.
 - f. A concrete seal shall be placed above the bentonite seal to grout the annulus through no less than the bottom ten feet of the High Plains aquifer (White River Formation).
 - g. The remainder of the well annulus shall be sealed with neat cement or bentonite grout from the top of the concrete seal to the ground surface.

Conclusions:

The Department of Environmental Quality has "no adverse" recommendations applicable to the Whispering Hills Subdivision.

Disclaimer:

The Non-Adverse recommendation provided above has nothing to do with, nor has any bearing on the water rights associated with the Whispering Hills Subdivision. Any questions or concerns about the water rights for the Whispering Hills Subdivision should be directed to the State Engineer's Office.

Nothing in Department of Environmental Quality recommendations or comments regarding the First American Title Insurance Co. Trust 8599, Wild West Development Co. Inc, and Ben F. Brooks III proposal for the Whispering Hills Subdivision shall be construed to relieve Ben F. Brooks III of the obligation to obtain any permits or additional approval from any local, state or federal agencies as required by law, rules, regulations, or ordinances.

Nothing in these recommendations commits the Department of Environmental Quality or Laramie County to the issuance of required permits for construction, operation, or modification of water supply or sewage systems
