

The above application for coverage under General Permit to Construct, Install, Modify or Operate a Small Wastewater Facility consisting of a 1000 gallon concrete septic tank to be used as a holding tank for a **seasonal cabin** with hauled water and a cistern in accordance with Chapter 3, Section 9 of the Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations has been reviewed and is hereby approved. You are authorized to construct, install or modify the small wastewater system in accordance with Chapter 11, Part D, Section 43 of the Water Quality Division Rules and Regulations, the general permit, the conditions listed below, and the materials submitted in your application package. Your attention is directed to the mandatory reporting requirements outlined in Part V, Section O of the general permit. Additionally, the following project specific conditions also apply:

1. Alarm Level Setting - the float that triggers the alarm system shall be set at $\frac{3}{4}$ of the depth of the liquid level depth at the bottom of the inlet pipe to the holding tank.
2. Holding Tank Pump-Out/Clean-Out Riser Requirement - The manways from the **holding tank compartment** must be extended to the ground surface.

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

to land apply waste wash water from compressor cooling fans according to the procedures and conditions of the application number 10-302. The facility is located at SW ¼ NW ¼ Section 25, T20N, R115W which is about 11 miles southeast of the Town of Kemmerer in the county of Lincoln, in the State of Wyoming. All construction, installation, or modification allowed by this permit shall be completed by December 31, 2010.

The issuance of this permit confirms that the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has evaluated the application submitted by the permittee and determined that it meets minimum applicable construction and design standards. The compliance with construction standards and the operation and maintenance of the facility to meet the engineer's design are the responsibility of the permittee, owner, and operator.

Granting this permit does not imply that DEQ guarantees or ensures that the permitted facility, when constructed, will meet applicable discharge permit conditions or other effluent or operational requirements. Compliance with discharge standards remains the responsibility of the permittee.

Nothing in this permit constitutes an endorsement by DEQ of the construction or the design of the facility described herein. This permit verifies only that the submitted application meets the design and construction standards imposed by Wyoming statutes, rules and regulations. The DEQ assumes no liability for, and does not in any way guarantee or warrant the performance or operation of the permitted facility. The permittee, owner and operator are solely responsible for any liability arising from the construction or operation of the permitted facility. By issuing this permit, the State of Wyoming does not waive its sovereign immunity.

The permittee shall allow authorized representatives from DEQ to enter and inspect any property, premise or place on or at which the facility is located or is being constructed or installed for the purpose of investigating actual or potential sources of water pollution, and for determining compliance or non-compliance with any rules, regulations, standards, permits or orders.

Nothing in this permit shall be construed to preclude the institution of any legal action or other proceeding to enforce any applicable provision of law or rules and regulations. It is the duty of the permittee, owner and operator to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws or regulations in the exercise of its activities authorized by this permit.

The issuance of this permit does not convey any property rights in either real or personal property or any invasion of personal rights, nor any infringement of federal, state or local laws or regulations.


The permittee shall construct and operate the permitted facility in accordance with the statements, representations, procedures, terms and conditions of the permit application, supporting documents and permit. This permit does not relieve the permittee from any duty to obtain any other permit or authorization that may be required by any provision of federal, state or local laws.

In carrying out its activities authorized by this permit, the permittee, owner and operator shall comply with all of the following permit conditions:

- 1 of 4 The applicant will provide immediate oral or written notice to the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Water Quality Division (WQD), Southwest District Engineer, 510 Meadow View Drive, Lander, WY 82520, 307-332-3144, FAX 307-332-3183, in accordance with the provisions of Section 11, Chapter 3, Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations of any changes or modifications which are not consistent with the terms and conditions of this permit.
- 2 of 4 Within sixty days of completion of construction of the authorized facility, the applicant will submit to the Northwest District a certification of completion signed by the Engineer of Record or the owner. A form titled "Certificate of Completion" has been provided.
- a. Date that construction of the facility was completed; and
 - b. Date that the facility was placed in operation; and
 - c. Certification the facility was constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of the permit; or
 - d. Certification the facility was completed with changes or modifications. Submittal of as-constructed plans and specifications for the system as it was constructed, certified by an engineer if appropriate is required. All modifications or deviations from the authorized plans must be highlighted.
- 3 of 4 The total allowable discharge of waste wash water per cooling fan set is 1000 gallons. Additional amounts require approval from the Southwest District Engineer.
- 4 of 4 The review and approval of this permit is based upon the items identified in the attached "Statement of Basis".


1. Permit Number: 10-302
2. Application reviewed for compliance with the following regulations:
Chapters 3 and 11 of the Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations.
3. Does the permit comply with all applicable regulations identified above?
Yes.
4. If a Section 17 of Chapter 3 review is required indicate the basis for determining groundwater will be protected.
Hydrocarbon/solvent free waste wash water with a cleaning surfactant solution, in amounts of about 30 gallons per cooling fan will be discharged on the ground surface directly below the cooling fans. The total discharge per cooling fan set is limited to 1000 gallons.
5. Documentation of Statement of Basis: The archive file for this permit includes adequate documentation of all sections of this Statement of Basis.

CERTIFICATION







2. Either a 6-inch diameter clean-out riser or a manway from each compartment of the septic tank must be extended to the ground surface from all septic tanks.

Findings as to the safety and adequacy of the proposed water system:

The proposed water system is individual water supply wells completed on each lot. Each well must be permitted by and constructed to the State Engineer's Office standards. If the individual water supply systems are large enough to be classified as Public Water Supply(PWS) systems, then a "Permit to Construct" for a PWS system will also have to be obtained from the Wyoming DEQ / WQD. The information submitted addresses the safety and adequacy of the proposed water system, provided compliance with the statements indicated in the "Notes required to be added to the final plat, and other pertinent documents", is adhered to.

Notes required to be added to the final plat, and other pertinent documents:

1. Individual on-site water-supply wells shall be installed in the White River Formation. Final well depth and construction details shall be determined with the depth and construction details based on the yield. *The minimum construction details are as follows:*
 - a. The wells shall be screened for a minimum length of 60 feet within confined, water-bearing zones of the White River Formation.
 - b. The top of the well screen shall be a minimum of 50 feet below the static water level in the White River Formation
 - c. The well shall have a solid inner casing from the ground surface to the top of screened interval.
 - d. The top of the sand filter/gravel pack shall be no less than ten feet below the top of the White River Formation.
 - e. A bentonite seal shall be placed on top of the sand filter, extending for at least five feet above the top of the filter, but no higher than the top of the White River Formation.
 - f. The remainder of the well annulus shall be sealed with neat cement or bentonite grout from the top of the concrete seal to the ground surface.

Conclusions:

The Department of Environmental Quality has "no adverse" recommendations applicable to the Swan Ranch Rail Park - RESUBMITTED Subdivision.

Disclaimer:

The Non-Adverse recommendation provided above has nothing to do with, nor has any bearing on the water rights associated with the Swan Ranch Rail Park - RESUBMITTED Subdivision. Any questions or concerns about the water rights for the Swan Ranch Rail

Park - RESUBMITTED Subdivision should be directed to the State Engineer's Office.

State Engineers Office staff has reviewed the subdivision application referenced above in compliance with W.S.18-5-306(c)(i). The proposed subdivision is in south Cheyenne, but not annexed to the City of Cheyenne off of East Fox Farm Road and East Jefferson Road between the South Greeley Highway and Avenue B-6. This development is anticipated to have 60 multi-family residential units in the southern portion of the project and an additional 92 multi-family residential units in the northern phase of the project. The Laramie County Environmental Health Department is requiring that all properties involved within this subdivision utilize the South Cheyenne Water and Sewer District (SCWSD) for both water distribution and sanitary sewer collection systems. The Cheyenne Board of Public Utilities has in place an overall master plan for the SCWSD. The study further states that, no surface or groundwater rights will be impacted by this development, and as such, no plans for the mitigation of water rights conflicts are in place for this subdivision. As a part of this review, a preliminary water right search was also conducted. Based upon a review of the information submitted, we offer the following comments:

1. Our preliminary search revealed numerous existing water right records in the name of the City of Cheyenne that recognize the proposed subdivision lands as being within the City's current service area.
2. Several well filing records of potential concern were also revealed. Please note that any well not to be used must be properly plugged and abandoned as outlined in the State Engineers Office Rules and Regulations, Part III, Water Well Minimum Construction Standards.

Therefore in summary, the State Engineers Office is generally supportive of approving the development of the proposed subdivision at this time. However, be advised that any number of events could occur at some point in the future which may preclude the State Engineer from issuing new permits for this type of activity.
